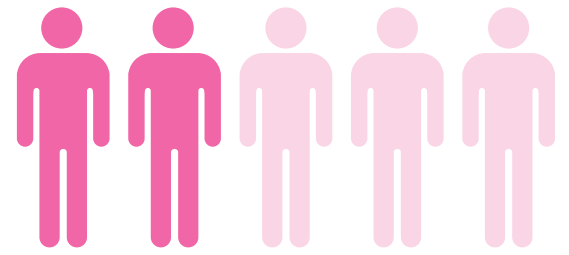

## What Women Should Know About the Affordable Care Act

Just before the Affordable Care Act expansion of health care coverage went into effect in 2014, approximately one in five American women ages 18-64 was uninsured. A closer look at the population shows more low-income women were uninsured during that time.



**40%** of low-income women reported being uninsured in 2013.
